There were 302 cows and 31 bulls. A large run of cows and bulls sold to a mostly higher market. Tops on packer cows was up \$6/cwt from last week, while the bulls were essentially unchanged. Demand remains very strong.

The calf market was consistent with last week's big rise despite averaging about \$6/cwt less. The overall quality in calves this week was not as high as last week. Several new highs were made in all classes. The market was active and demand was very strong across the board.
