There were 272 cows and 18 bulls. Top packer bull was at \$120/cwt, while tops on packer cows was at \$100.00/cwt. Culling has started up north and this market was strong despite the large supply. The market was steady with the same levels of the past few months.

The calf market was very consistent with the last few weeks. This week the average weight was 29 pounds lighter, but the price was over \$3.35/cwt higher. Demand is strong and drought concerns are not weighing on the market quite as much.
