There were 135 cows and 22 bulls. The top packer bull was at \$115/cwt, while tops on packer cows was at \$95/cwt. A small supply sold well in light of heavy marketings on packer cattle this time of year.

The calf market was higher on weights under 500 pounds and steady on weights above 650 pounds. Weights between 500 and 650 were weaker. The average weight was almost 24 pounds lighter. The average price was \$1.05/cwt lower. Market was strong on all classes with some being at a lower level.
