There were 64 cows and 12 bulls. The packer market was steady with last week. Lower numbers to test the market due to much needed rain in the area. The top packer bull was at \$112/cwt, while the top cow was \$95/cwt.

The calf market was solid and demand was strong. Optimism from the widespread rain was definitely seen here today with the market being higher across the board. The overall average today was over \$6/cwt higher on 7 lbs less weight, an increase of over \$13 per head.
