There were 101 cows and 14 bulls. Tops on packer cows was at \$101/cwt, while the top bull was up \$7/cwt at \$122/cwt. Demand remains very strong as the seasonal demand is high and numbers low.

The calf market was once again much stronger across the board by over \$9/cwt and over \$50/head. Most all of the middle weights saw jumps as much as \$20-25/cwt, new highs across the board. Demand continued to be incredibly strong.
