There were 158 cows and 32 bulls. Tops on packer cows was at \$96/cwt, while the top bull was again at \$122/cwt. Demand remains very strong as the seasonal demand is high and numbers moderate.

The calf market was consistent with last week with new tops in over half of the weight/sex categories. Overall, the average price was steady with last week's market. A very strong and steady market especially shown by the number of new tops.
