There were 243 cows and 29 bulls. The packer market was a little higher on both packer cows and bulls. Top packer cow was at \$111/cwt while the top packer bull was at \$128/cwt.

The calf market was much higher for second sale in a row. Average price was over \$4.60/cwt higher and value per head over \$20 more. Strong demand after record setting fat cattle prices coupled with a softer market for corn pushed the market to new heights.
