There were 338 cows and 24 bulls. It was another solid market on cows and bulls with the top packer bull at \$122/cwt, while tops on packer cows was at \$98.00/cwt. Culling has started up north and this typically weighs down the packer market with excess supply.

The calf market rebounded from last week with calves averaging \$5.38/cwt more on over 36 more pounds of weight. Demand was strong for high quality calves, as some easing of drought concerns helped greatly.
