There were 135 cows and 21 bulls. Top packer bull was up \$7/cwt to \$147/cwt, while the top packer cow was up \$5/cwt at \$130/cwt. Prices continue to climb higher as demand continues to be very strong, resulting in record highs on packer bulls and cows.

The calf market was again higher even on top of last week's jump. Weights under 550 pounds were particularly much higher. Demand remains incredibly strong across the board. Calves were \$16/hd higher on 17 pounds more weight.
