There were 191 cows and 25 bulls. Packer bulls were up \$3/cwt to \$165, while the top cow was up \$3/cwt to \$140. Another solid week with strong demand.

The calf market was higher across the board. Calves averaged \$10/cwt higher on 10 lbs less weight, adding over \$30 more per head. It was a strong and active market.
