There were 159 cows and 14 bulls. Packer cows and bulls sold to another week of strong demand. Tops on packer bulls was at \$165, while top cow was at \$150. Each week continues to see prices at or near all-time highs. Demand continues to be very strong.

The calf market was once again higher as demand is growing. All classes of calves are in high demand and were stronger. The average calf value was almost \$4/hd higher despite 24 pounds less weight.
