There were 192 cows and 30 bulls. Strong record high market on packer cattle continued as tops on packer bulls at \$175/cwt while tops on cows was \$154/cwt. Demand continues to be very strong.

The calf market was stronger across the board as strong demand continues. All classes were in line with previous weeks. Calves average over 24 more pounds of weight resulting in over \$54 per head more value. A great day to sell.
