There were 144 cows and 19 bulls. Packer market continued its strong run of prices at levels consistent with last several weeks. Tops on packer bulls was at \$170/cwt while tops on cows was \$145/cwt.

The calf market looked solid with the last several weeks. There were some classes where the tops were off as much as \$10/cwt. Overall, strong demand remains as quality calves continue to sell at high levels.
