There were 181 cows and 24 bulls. Packer market continued its strong run of prices at high levels consistent with the last several weeks. Tops on packer bulls was at \$175/cwt, while tops on cows was \$147/cwt.

The calf market was steady with a lower undertone, probably due to the stock market dropping. Strong demand continues just at a lower level. However, in most classes there were new highs but overall quality was less.
