Number of Head: 1,071

There were 100 cows and 18 bulls. Packer market was strong for the limited number of head on hand. Prices were at levels consistent with the last several weeks. Tops on packer bulls was up to \$171/cwt, while tops on cows was \$142/cwt.

The calf market was definitely higher than last week's levels. Demand is strong leading to a very active market. The fundamentals of supply and demand point to a higher market, but the live cattle futures have not reflected that.
