There were 85 cows and 22 bulls. Packer market continued its strong run of prices at high levels consistent with the last several weeks. Tops on packer bulls was at \$176/cwt, while tops on cows was \$147/cwt.

The calf market was a little lower. Lower grades tended to show more weakness, but number one quality calves continued to sell at high levels.
