There were 191 cows and 27 bulls. Packer market on cows was weaker for the first time in months as fall runs are bringing more to the market. Tops on packer bulls was at \$171/cwt, while tops on cows was up to \$127/cwt.

The calf market was steady with last week's levels. Demand is still strong leading to a very active market. Calves under 400 pounds were a little higher while heavier calves showed some weakness. The fundamentals of supply and demand continue to point to a higher market, but the futures market has not reflected that.
