There were 127 cows and 22 bulls. Packer market was strong again for the limited number of head on hand. Prices were at levels consistent with the last several weeks. Tops on packer bulls was at \$170/cwt, while tops on cows was up to \$149/cwt.

The calf market was still active, just at a lower tone. Demand is still strong leading to a very active market. The fundamentals of supply and demand continue to point to a higher market, but the futures market has not reflected that.
