There were 170 cows and 37 bulls. Packer market on cows and bulls were higher after a couple of weeks declining value. Tops on packer bulls were up at \$8 to \$167/cwt, while tops on cows was at \$125/cwt.

The calf market was steady and the demand is still strong leading to a very active market. Calves over 500 pounds were a little higher while the rest of classes were fully steady. The fundamentals of supply and demand continue to point to a continued high market. The dry conditions are putting stress on sellers and buyers.
