Following our Good Friday break, we returned to a record-breaking sale this week. We had 350 cows, 26 bulls, and 15 sheep/goats. The market showed exceptional strength across all categories: packer cows traded \$3–\$5 higher, while the bull market saw a significant jump of \$10–\$12. Calf demand was particularly aggressive, with prices surging \$5–\$30 higher strong buyer demand.
