We saw a total of **1291** head this week, including 258 cows, 35 bulls, and 12 sheep/goats. Prices for cows eased by \$5–\$7, while the bull market remained steady to \$2 lower. Following last week's record highs, the calf market also saw a correction. Despite a downward trend on the commodity board over the last three days, buyer demand remains strong.
