Total volume reached **1,325** head this week, including 82 cows and 23 bulls. Packer cow and bull prices held steady with last week, but the calf market saw another downturn. The board fell for three consecutive days, further driven down by news of Tyson plant closures. While underlying demand remains strong, buyers are holding back due to recent market volatility.
