Weekly volume reached **1,510** head of cattle, which included 133 cows and 17 bulls. Packer cow and bull prices dropped by \$5–\$10. Meanwhile, news of 300,000 metric tons of duty-free ground beef entering the U.S. pushed calf prices lower. While underlying demand remains solid, buyers are taking a cautious approach in response to market uncertainty.
